

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON INTENTION  
TO FORM DEPOSITORY TRUST COMPANY OF DELAWARE, LLC**

The State Bank Commissioner hereby gives notice of a public hearing to consider the application of FidelityTrade Incorporated, a Delaware Corporation, to be filed for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Advantage with respect to the formation of Depository Trust Company of Delaware, LLC.

A Notice of Intent to form Depository Trust Company of Delaware, LLC, was filed with the Office of the State Bank Commissioner on June 2, 2009. It is proposed that the new limited purpose trust company will be located in Wilmington, New Castle County, Delaware, and have capital stock of \$500,000.

A public hearing to consider the application shall commence at 10:00 a.m. on August 11, 2009, in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor Conference Room of the Carvel State Office Building, 820 North French Street, Wilmington, Delaware 19801. The hearing is to be conducted pursuant to the provisions of Sections 726, 776 and 777 of Title 5 of the Delaware Code and State Bank Commissioner Regulations 701 and 702.

A copy of the proposed form of application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Advantage is on file in the Office of the State Bank Commissioner, 555 E. Loockerman Street, Suite 210, Dover, Delaware 19901, and the non-confidential portions thereof are available for inspection during regular office hours.

Interested parties may appear at the public hearing, in person or by counsel or other representatives, and may present evidence relevant to the issues to be decided at that time. The Commissioner will make a decision on the basis of the evidence received.
